

Nikolay A. Konovalov, MD, PhD, is a Professor and Chairman of Spinal Neurosurgery department at Burdenko Neurosurgical Center in Moscow, Russia. He finished his medical studies at Moscow Medical Academy in 1994, after that completing his neurosurgical residency and spine fellowship at Burdenko Neurosurgical Center. After his fellowship, prof. Konovalov did extensive post-doctoral training in hospitals in Western Europe and USA (Columbia University, NY, USA; UCLA, LA, USA; USC, LA, USA). He is currently a Corresponding member of the Russian Academy of Sciences, the President Elect of the Russian Association of Spinal Surgeons, Board Member of the Russian Association of Neurosurgeons, Member of the EANS Spine Section Panel, EANS Training Committee, EANS International Relations Committee and WFNS Spine Committee.

His clinical interests include spinal cord and vertebral tumors, degenerative diseases of the spine, spinal cord trauma and regenerative therapy, spinal deformity and developmental anomalies.

As for his time with the EANS, in 2003 he finished the 4-year EANS European Training Course in Neurosurgery, later appointed as a member of the EANS Training Committee and Spine Section Panel. In 2019 he successfully hosted the first ever EANS course in Moscow, Russia.

He is currently on the editorial board of Burdenko's Journal of Neurosurgery and three other major Russian neurosurgical journals - Russian Journal of Neurosurgery, The Journal "Hirurgia Pozvonochnika" (Spine surgery), Acta Biomedica Scientifica.
